



INTERNATIONAL CLIMBING CAMP

***CLIMBING WITHOUT BORDERS ***

Geyibayiri (Antalya), TURKEY

13-18 April 2009

The main goal of this youth climbing camp is for climbers to come to Turkey, to climb together and to go back with higher level of climbing and more experience. The leaders will teach them how to reach a higher level, for example: if somebody climbs 6a, after these 6 days to start climbing 6b.

- **Date:** 13 – 18 April 2009
- **Place:** Geyikbayiri, Antalya in the south of Turkey. Climbing camp in forest surrounding with lots of cliffs. With almost 500 routes on the cliffs at the moment.
- **Accommodation:** Jo.Si.To guest house & camp, sleeping in tents (organizer will provide them). The camp is 5 minute walk from the cliffs and 40km from Antalya Airport. There is internet on site and a games area. See http://climbingcamp-antalya.com/index.php5?camp_area/camp_info for more information about the site and the climbing.
- **Food:** All meals and lunch packs are provided by the event organisers.
- **Management:** team of sport climbers and youth leaders from Macedonian Mountain Sport Federation and Mountaineering Federation of Turkey.
- **Participants:** Young people from 16 to 29 years old. Participants should lead climb at a minimum of 6a French grade. They must be able to tie in sagely, thread anchors at the top of climbs, lead and top rope belay. We will be offering places to a maximum of 6 participants per country Federation.

Participants younger than 18 years old must be accompanied by an adult Climber/coach, who is able to look after them during this meet.

- **Equipment:** climbing harness, climbing shoes, chalk bag, climbing helmet, rope (60m), belay device and 15 quick draws (UIAA standard/CEN). Sun glasses & cream, waterproof, sleeping bag, Kari mat, head torch, climbing clothing and wash kit, water bottle, any personal medication.
- **Insurance:** Participants should get themselves insurance for accident, rescue, third party liability and travel which is valid for participating in the programme of climbing and other events in Turkey. This cover note of insurance should be presented to the organisers on arrival.
- **Entry visas:** If your representatives need to obtain Entry Visas to Turkey please confirm their names and passport numbers to the contact emails as soon as possible as Visa processing is a very lengthy process.
- **Price:** 220 EUR per participant, payable on arrival to the organiser. Included is accommodation, full board, leading and organisational costs.
- **Registration deadline:** 13 of March 2009
- **Meeting point:** Camp & Guest house JOSITO in Geyikbayiri, Antalya. Registration desk for all participants will be in the camp, opened at 13th of March, until 24.00h.
- **Additional information and registration:**
Organisers are Mountaineering Federation of Turkey and Macedonian Mountain Sport Federation, Mumin Karabas sport climbing instructor and guide and Vladimir Trpovski sport climbing instructor and youth leader and in cooperation with Camp&Guest House JoSiTo.

- The camp will provide a platform for international debate and discussion on current topics concerning climbing worldwide during the evenings. Also we will have a demonstration of famous alpine and sport climber Alex Klenov as well as some movies and pictures by Tobias, owner of the camp who has made about 70% of the routes in Geyikbayiri.
