This tour allows you to stop in one of the most well-known and historical places in Moscow - Poklonnaya Hill. It is a memorial complex dedicated to Russia's military victories in two great wars - the Napoleonic War and World War II.

The Memorial includes Victory Park with monuments and fountains, the 141.8 meter high main Victory Obelisk, the Central Museum of the Great Patriotic War of 1941-1945, the Church of Great Martyr and Victory Bearer St. George, the memorial Mosque, and the memorial Synagogue with the Holocaust Memorial Museum, constructed in memory of people of different religions who perished in the War.

There also are open-air exhibitions of weapons and combat equipment, including specimens of material of the navy and the railroad forces, and engineering structures.

You will pass all these sights in a comfortable tram with audioquide.

Description: Kremlin Grounds, Cathedrals and Patriarch's Palace Tour. The small city in the center of Moscow, once the residence of Czars and Patriarchs, contains Russia's main cathedrals, Assumption Cathedral, Archangel's Cathedral and Resurrection Cathedral. The Patriarch's Palace is a Museum of Seventeenth-century Life and Applied Art, displaying ecclesiastical regalia, period furniture, gold and silver ware from Russia and Western Europe. The palace was begun in 1640 and it incorporates the Church of the Twelve Apostles, which was the private place of worship for the patriarchs.

Don't bring large size bags with you; otherwise you will have to leave them at the cloak room by the Kremlin. It will cost 60 rubles/bag.

Description: Trip to Kolomenskoye, a unique oasis in the center of Moscow, and the summer residence of the Czars since the time of Ivan the Terrible. Its church, built in 1530, was once called the Eighth Wonder of the World, and the oak trees are at least as old as everything else in the park. You will see the house of Peter the Great and will visit the folk art museum and the museum of wooden architecture with its samples of houses from northern Russia.
